



I-25/Raton Pass Rockfall Mitigation

Rockfall Mitigation Announcement on Interstate 25 Raton Pass

Project Overview

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) and Rock Solid Solutions will be doing rockfall mitigation on Interstate (I) 25 in Las Animas County, south of Trinidad Colorado. The project will include blasting, excavation, and the removal of overhanging rocks.

Project Schedule and Information

Rockfall mitigation on I-25 will start Monday, March 27, 2017, and will begin at mile point (MP) 3 and continue to MP 11. The project will be in operation Monday-Friday, 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Anticipated completion date is August 2017.

Travel & Other Impacts

Motorists can expect brief delays during blasting operations.

Starting April 3, 2017, northbound traffic can expect a single lane closure with a 13 ft width restriction from MP 5 - MP 6.

Starting April 24, 2017, the northbound lane will be closed 24/7. Both north and southbound traffic will share the southbound lane between MP 3 and MP 11. There will be a 10 ft width restriction during this time. Lane closures will conclude August 7, 2017.
