Ongoing Traffic Impacts

Rockfall Mitigation on Interstate (I) 25 will begin at mile point (MP) 3 and continue to MP 11. The detour is in place. For the duration of the project, north and southbound traffic will share the southbound lanes between MP 3 and MP 11 with a reduced speed of 55 mph. There will be a 10 ft width restriction 24/7 during this time. Traffic at Exit 6 and Exit 8 wanting to go north on I-25 will need to travel south to Exit 2 to go north. Motorists can expect possible delays.

This week crews will haul off rock and slope cleanup.

The project will be in operation Monday - Friday from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.

Drivers are asked to obey all speed limit reductions and construction road signs during this time, and please move all accidents from traffic lanes.
