Planning/Discussion/Action Items:

2 April POA Board Meeting Re-cap:

- For some unknown reason the Google Meet virtual presentation ended prior to the Board Meeting. Deb will contact Sarah Duncan to identify the correct steps to prevent this from re-occurring.
 - o Need to develop clear written instructions to prevent the early shut-down.
 - o Incorporate I-Pod / Google Meet join instructions and test prior to the next Board Meeting (4 June 2022).
 - John discussed the screen sharing difficulties he exhibited as a virtual attendee.
- Communications Committee support was at a minimum due to recently losing two
 members. Additional support is required to ensure both in-person and virtual
 audiences can see and hear the presentations.
- In person audience comments called for additional microphones, the Committee will
 ensure that the audience microphone remains stationary and board members will
 share the president's microphone.

Style Guide, Web Site Layout, and Posts: Deb Johnson led the discussion reviewing 5th Wheel's web page style guide. Current document is very basic, and the Committee stated that a more in-depth document is desired. Deb will contact 5th Wheel seeking its availability. The Committee discussed standardizing pages within a topic on the SFTR web site, i.e. seeking to make all pages present the same view; currently there are different views within Committees/Groups on the web site; it is desired that all pages within topic present the same layout. On 28 March Deb coordinated a meeting with 5th Wheel to discus and clarify Style Guide and web page needs. 5th Wheel will develop a proposal with cost. More to follow when they respond.

Budget: Current balance sits at \$3058.23. Total future commitments will be established after 5th Wheel submits their cost proposal. Potential additional budget needs include:

- 1 copy of MS Office 365 for committee computer: \$69-99.00
